

# Michigan City company sponsors new scholarship for tech students

MICHIGAN CITY — Michigan City-based, JM2 Webdesigners, has introduced a new scholarship available to Purdue University North Central students. The JM2 Webdesigners Jump Start Scholarship is offered to PNC students pursuing a degree in the technology program.

The \$1,000 award will be given to a selected student at the start of the 2013-2014 school year. The funds will be applied to the student's tuition, paying \$500 for the fall semester and \$500 for the spring semester.

Applications will be available at [www.pnc.edu/scholarships](http://www.pnc.edu/scholarships). Applicants must also submit a 1,000-word essay answering the question, "What is the significance of this scholarship to you and your needs as a technology student for your future technology goals?"

The school will narrow down the number of applicants to three with the final winner chosen by JM2 Webdesigners co-owners, Jon Meyers and John Marx.

Requirements for applicants include a 3.0 or higher grade point average and full-time status with the school. The applicant may be a technology student of freshman, sophomore, junior or senior level.

"We wanted to give back to the community," Meyers said. "And being an alumni, PNC has been good to me."

According to the company's website, Meyers and Marx "decided that the only way to cultivate an environment for growth in the local area was to promote technology in the local college system, Purdue North Central."
